A Google search shows that an average of a dozen books are read by Americans each year, but there is an acknowledgement that the stats are skewed by those who read a great deal.

Well, I would be one of those, probably labeled a voracious reader, especially of fiction. I had a new personal best in 2025: 104 books. That worked out to 29,951 pages, or 82.06 pages read per day.

How do I find these books? I subscribe to Kindle Unlimited. For a little over \$12 a month, I can read as many books as I want, and in the process, help indie writers like myself. That ends up being \$1.38 per book, plus the hours of enjoyment. It's not as cheap as the library, but that's fine with me.

I encourage you to set a goal of reading more this year. I can assure you there is some great Christian fiction out there.

And hopefully, you will read one of my books this year. Or maybe two... or three... or...
